This is an event run by the Parents' Association for the students of Wellington Girls' College. To ensure that the evening is safe and enjoyable, all students who wish to attend the Ball must:

- Return the completed attached application form and ensure it is signed by their parent/guardian;
- Arrange for their partner and partner's parent/guardian to sign the appropriate form;
- Agree to follow all College rules throughout the evening relating to behaviour, including the following:

## **Conditions of Entry**

## Arrival and Entry to the Ball

- Entry to the Ball is between 7.30pm 8.15pm. Students and partners will not be permitted to enter the Ball after this time.
- All coats, jackets and bags will be searched prior to entry into the Ball.
- Security guards of the same sex as the person seeking entry may conduct a pat down search prior to entry into the Ball.
- Any students or partners attempting to bring alcohol or drugs to the Ball will be refused entry to the ball.
- Any students or partners who arrive at the Ball and who have been drinking (or appear to have been drinking), or appear to be under the influence of drugs, will be refused entry to the Ball.
- Students or partners may be asked to undergo a breathalyser test as a condition of entry to the Ball.



- Any students or partners who refuse to undergo a breathalyser test when requested to do so by a teacher will be denied entry to the Ball.
- If any students or partners are denied entry to the Ball for failure to comply with these conditions of entry, their parents will be contacted and required to collect them from the venue. No refunds will be given.

## Conduct during the Ball

- No alcohol, drugs, or smoking are permitted at the venue.
- Any students or partners who appear to have been drinking may be asked to undergo a breathalyser test.
- Students and/or partners will be removed from the Ball if:
  - They are caught drinking or taking drugs during the evening;
  - They appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
  - They consent to and undergo a breathalyser test which returns a positive reading;
  - They refuse to undergo a breathalyser test when requested to do so by a teacher;
  - They demonstrate unacceptable behaviour.
- Parents will be required to collect any students or partners who are removed from the Ball. No refunds will be given.

## Departure from the Ball

 Students and partners will only be allowed to leave the venue between 10.45pm – 11.00pm. No pass-outs will be issued.

All parents/guardians must take responsibility for their daughter's transport and arrangements prior to and after the Ball.

Students who wish to make an application to attend the Ball must complete the attached application form, and ensure that partners and parents complete the relevant forms. These must be returned to the student office by Friday 12th April. If the application is approved by the principal, payment for the Ball must be made by Friday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019.
