



# WELLINGTON GIRLS' COLLEGE

## **CLASSROOM CONDUCT**

- Follow instructions: the teacher is in charge.
- Be on time to class.
- Bring all the equipment that you need.
- Consider the rights of others to learn – don't be noisy or disruptive.
- Leave the room clean and tidy.
- Exit when told by the teacher.
- Eating, drinking or chewing gum is not permitted without the teacher's consent.
- Offensive language or behaviour is not permitted.

## **CONDUCT AT SCHOOL**

- There will be no smoking, vaping, drinking of alcohol, or use of other illegal drugs.
- Regulation uniform to be worn at all times including to and from school.
- Teacher permission must be gained before leaving a classroom, the school grounds, or an off campus activity.
- Students are expected to maintain good attendance.
- Respect must be shown for the property of others. There will be no stealing.
- Vandalism of school property is not tolerated.
- Appropriate behaviour on public transport is expected.
- Threatening or abusive language, harassment, intimidation of others, social media bullying and any form of violence is not tolerated.

## **CONDUCT OUTSIDE SCHOOL**

- You must obey New Zealand law. This includes not illegally using, purchasing or possessing alcohol, drugs, cigarettes or other harmful controlled substances and not engaging in inappropriate physical contact with others.
- You must live in a school approved homestay, a boarding hostel, with a designated caregiver or with your parents. You may not live independently.
- You must obey the rules of your residential caregiver, including curfews, as set out in the contract you have signed with them and the school.
- You are not permitted to get married while you are attending Wellington Girls' College as an international student.
- You are not to drive a motor vehicle except for the purposes of gaining a valid New Zealand driving license under the guidance of a licensed driving instructor.
- You need prior approval from the Principal and your natural parents for any trip or holiday outside the Wellington region if you are not travelling with your host family, the school or your own family. Adventure activities will also need approval from the school and natural parents.
- You may not use a ride share app if you are under 18
- There should be no illegal downloading of material from the internet.
- To work part time while attending Year 12 or 13 at Wellington Girls' College, you require the consent of Wellington Girls' College, your parents and a Variation of Conditions to your visa.
- Threatening or abusive language, harassment, intimidation of others, social media bullying and any form of violence is not tolerated.
