WGC ART AWARD 2022



The competition is open to all students at Wellington Girls' College. There is no theme, just enter your best work.

Entries are due at the end of the second day of Term 3 by 4pm (Tuesday, 26 July), and are to be handed into the Student Office - no exceptions for late entries. **The work must be submitted anonymously, along with a sealed envelope with the completed entry form and an A4 colour photo of the work inside.** This will be opened by the Principal's PA (Ann Gilbert) for administrative purposes, but kept secret from the Art department and Judges.

The following information must all be followed and/or provided or the work will not be eligible for judging:

ENTRIES

Any 2D medium – painting, drawing, photography, print, mixed media – artworks are to \it{not} be presented in glass or a frame

NO PORTRAITURE OR SCULPTURAL PIECES

Can be collaborative 2D artwork (sharing prize money)

A student may enter up to two artworks per year

Are anonymous so must not be signed

Works must be on good quality paper which can be collected from the Student Office and Art department, but all other materials must be provided by the student.

The Art department will undertake an initial check of the entries. If they feel any work is largely underdeveloped or is of inappropriate content, it will not be exhibited. An external panel of judges will then be invited to make the final decision as to the Winner and Highly Commended recipient.

All selected entries will be displayed prior to the WGC Art Award announcement. The winners will be announced at a private function to which all entrants, their families, the Board and staff will be invited. This function will be hosted by the Arts Committee, the Visual Art department and the Principal.

Both Winner and Highly Commended recipients will receive a cash prize and a certificate, and for the Winner, an acknowledgement on the Art Wall.

The winning artwork will become the property of Wellington Girls' College and form part of the permanent art collection of the school. The work will be displayed and may be used by Wellington Girls' College in any promotional material (but must be attributed).

The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
