Background

The Education Review Office reviews schools that are signatories to the *Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021* established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020.

Findings

The school is a signatory to the Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021 established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020. The school has attested that it complies with all aspects of the Code and has completed an annual self review of its implementation of the Code.

At the time of this review there were 56 international students attending the school.

The school has well-established, highly effective processes for annual self-review and its provision of pastoral care. It draws on a range of good quality information, including student, family and agent voice, to support it to review and improve its international student programme and pastoral support.

The school board is well informed about developments and outcomes for students and uses this information to plan strategically for the future of the programme. The international department effectively fosters partnerships with other schools, tertiary providers and professional bodies to enhance education provision and pastoral care for students.

Students are very effectively supported to make positive transitions to New Zealand, school and homestays. Learning programmes respond well to students' aspirations and needs and students achieve well in New Zealand qualifications. Students' academic progress and wellbeing is closely monitored and appropriately responded to. Transitions to tertiary learning and post-school pathways, both in New Zealand and overseas, are well planned and supported.
